Home Safety & Comfort

- ☐ Doors and windows close and lock properly
- ☐ No visible water damage under sinks or around fixtures
- ☐ Exterior lighting works and covers entry areas
- ☐ Walkways, stairs, and railings feel stable and secure
- ☐ Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are installed and working
- ☐ Emergency exits are clear and accessible
- ☐ Seasonal items (gutters, hoses, outdoor drains) are checked
- ☐ No unusual odors, moisture, or signs of mold

Digital Safety Basics

- ☐ Home Wi-Fi is password protected
- ☐ Router login information has been changed from default
- ☐ Devices are set to update automatically
- ☐ Strong, unique passwords are used for important accounts
- ☐ Two-step verification is enabled where available
- ☐ Unknown devices are not connected to your network
- ☐ Public Wi-Fi is avoided for sensitive activities
